

10 proposals to save the cultural sector in Italy

N.1

Increase the crisis fund to €200M and devise objective criteria for allocating the money to everyone on the industry, live, recording industry, publishing and so on.

N. 2

An amount from the government to cover income lost during lockdown

N. 3

Tax and contributions holiday, with repayment over a number of years, with a particular attention to those sectors that rely on neighbouring rights and copyright, for whom a decrease in earnings will arrive in the next 2 years.

N. 4

Voucher for live shows to be valid for 18 months other than 12

N. 5

A family Culture Bonus (an extension of the €500 bonus given by the State to everyone on their 18th birthday). Tax Credit for all recordings, same as for the cinema.

N. 6

A reduction of VAT rate to 4% for recorded music and live shows.

N. 7

Emergency income support for those workers with seasonal contracts.

N. 8

A complete revision of the fiscal system for live music companies, including VAT rates, quick rebates and no split payments.

N. 9

Interface with Vittorio Colao's task force to illustrate our views on the measures to be adopted to allow live shows to start again.

Certainty on times
